A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF COFFMAN COVE, ALASKA AMENDING THE EMPLOYEE HANDBOOK TO INCLUDE LANGUAGE ADDRESSING CHILDREN IN THE WORKPLACE

WHEREAS, the City of Coffman Cove, as an employer, seeks to periodically review its employee handbook, establishing personnel policies that provide a professional, orderly and safe working environment for employees and customers; and

WHEREAS, the City expects its employees to follow rules of conduct that will protect the interests and safety of all employees and those the City serves; and

WHEREAS, having children in the workplace not only increases violations of safety standards but prevents a more conscientious and considerate environment for employees and customers alike; and

WHEREAS, the City requires all employees to arrange childcare prior to working so that workplace etiquette remains a priority and equitable treatment of all employees is ensured; and

WHEREAS, disciplinary action including verbal warning, written warning, suspension with or without pay, or termination of employment, depending on the severity of the problem and number of occurrences, may be implemented.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, Section 701: "Employee Conduct and Work Rules" of the Employee Handbook shall be amended to include the aforementioned language regarding children in the workplace.
