

## Harbor Rate Scale Amendments

- Floating Slips: \$17/foot annually, with an annual rate increase of \$2/year, every other year, for the next 10 years. Beginning October 2022 and ending October 2032.
- Skiff Ramp Slips: \$15/foot annually



## Garbage Pick-Up

- Please make sure all garbage cans are clearly labeled with last name of owner and physical address.
- Garbage Pick-up days: Garbage pick-up will be every Friday.
