- Reg. Council Meeting: Thursday, November 17<sup>th</sup> @ 6:30 pm.

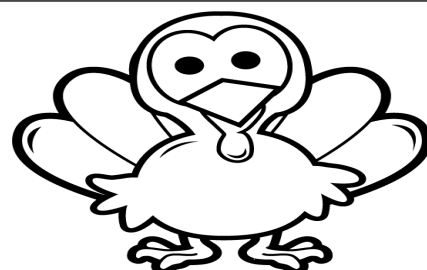
### *Fire Department*

### *Harbor Rate Scale Amendments*

- Floating Slips: \$17/foot annually, with an annual rate increase of \$2/year, every other year for the next 10 years, beginning October 2022 and ending October 2032.
- Skiff Ramp Slips: \$15/foot annually.
