

City of Coffman Cove Ordinance 18 03

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COFFMAN COVE, ALASKA AMENDING THE WORDING OF TITLE X HARBOR, SECTION 10.01.020 DEFINITIONS: PARAGRAPH L, LENGTH OF VESSEL.

Section 1. Purpose.

To add, delete and amend the language of TITLE X Harbor.

Section 2. Classification.

This Ordinance is of general and permanent nature and shall become part of the Municipal Code.

Section 3. Prior Ordinance superseded.

This Code supersedes any and all Ordinances adopted prior to this code and not included within this Code at the time of this Code's adoption.

Section 4. Severability.

If in any provision of this Ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

Section 5. Titles and Chapters adopted.

TITLE X HARBOR, SECTION 10.01.020 DEFINITIONS: PARAGRAPH L, LENGTH OF VESSEL.

L. "Vessel length" is defined for non-commercial vessels as the manufacturer's specified overall hull length (when available) or by direct measurement (when not available) excluding detachable motors. For commercial vessels the vessel length is as listed in the State of Alaska CFEC database (if available) or by direct measurement (when not available) to include anything that extends the length of the vessel.

~~[L. "Vessel length" means the length of the vessel used to determine moorage fees and consists of the overall length of the vessel measured in a straight line from stem to stern plus all appurtenances that extend the length of the vessel, such as bowsprits, C drives, stern drives, skiffs, etc.]~~

AS FOLLOWS:




