Ordinance 16-03

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COFFMAN COVE ADOPTING NEW WORDING FOR THE USE OF
FORKLIFTS WITHIN CITY LIMITS TITLE XII STREETS, SIDEWALKS AND PUBLIC PLACES

Section 1. Purpose

To add language to TITLE XII

Section 2. Classification.

This Ordinance is of general and permanent nature and shall become part of the Municipal Code.

Section 3. Prior Ordinance superseded.

This Code supersedes any and all Ordinances adopted prior to this code and not included within this Code at the time of the Code's adoption.

Section 4. Severability.

If in any provision of the Ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

Section 5. Titles and Chapters adopted.

Section 12.01.080 Use of Forklifts on City Streets

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COFFMAN COVE CITY COUNCIL, AS FOLLOWS: (New language *italics and underlined*, deleted language ~~(in brackets and stricken)~~.)

Chapter 12.03
Section 12.01.080 Use of Forklifts on City Streets

- A. Drivers shall be licensed. It is prohibited for a person to drive a forklift within the city limits without having a valid driver's license.
- B. All drivers of forklifts on City streets must have a current forklift operator certificate. It is a violation of Federal law for anyone UNDER 18 years of age to operate a forklift or for anyone OVER 18 years of age who is not properly trained and certified to do so.
- C. Driving while license canceled, suspended, revoked or in violation of a limitation. It is prohibited for a person to drive a forklift upon a city street when that person's driver's license has been canceled, suspended or revoked, or a violation of a limitation placed upon that person's license.

- D. Reckless driving. It is prohibited for a person to drive a forklift on city streets in a manner that creates a substantial and unjustifiable risk of harm to a person or to property or could actually endanger a person or property.
- E. Forklift use will not be permitted between the hours of dusk and dawn unless the forklift is equipped with proper lighting.
