

**City of Coffman Cove
Ordinance 16-02**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COFFMAN COVE, ALASKA AMENDING THE
WORDING OF TITLE VII UTILITIES**

Section 1. Purpose.

To add, delete and amend the language of TITLE VII

Section 2. Classification.

This Ordinance is of general and permanent nature and shall become part of the Municipal Code.

Section 3. Prior Ordinance superseded.

This Code supersedes any and all Ordinances adopted prior to this code and not included within this Code at the time of this Code's adoption.

Section 4. Severability.

If in any provision of this Ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

Section 5. Titles and Chapters amended.

Section 7.04.200 Non-sufficient funds check

~~A twenty-five dollar charge will be made when a customer tenders payment with a non-sufficient funds check.~~

Customers tendering payment with a non-sufficient funds check will be charged a fee equal to the corresponding bank charges.

When the city is notified by the customer's bank that there are insufficient funds to cover the check tendered for water and sewer services, the city may require the customer to pay in cash or by money order to guarantee the customer's payment to the city.

No customer who tenders a non-sufficient funds check will be relieved of obligation to pay the city under the original terms of the bill and entitled to defer the city's right to disconnect service for non-payment of bills.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COFFMAN COVE CITY COUNCIL, AS FOLLOWS:
